OUR MODEL

G2W has three main components: group mentoring, community service, and recreational events.

GROUP MENTORING

Our mentoring circles meet weekly from October to May during the school day, typically for 50 minutes to 1 hour. They are located in several middle schools within Chesterfield County. We also have a Community circle that is open to high school girls. We talk about topics related to the transition from girlhood to womanhood: body image, self-love, healthy relationships, mindfulness, empowerment and so much more. Our curriculum follows a PIES format, focusing on the physical, intellectual, emotional, and social aspect of the self.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Community service helps our mentees learn the importance of servicing others as a part of our own journey. Some of the community service projects we have done include volunteering at Chesterfield Food Bank and organizing a canned food drive for housing and food insecure people.

RECREATIONAL EVENTS

We know how to have fun, too! We regularly do fun activities in our circles, including playing games, arts/crafts, yoga, creating vision boards, etc., but some of the larger scale recreational events we've done include whitewater rafting and indoor/outdoor rock climbing!
